

DECLARATION ON PEACE IN SYRIA

of the Assembly of Convergence at the World Social Forum

In Tunis different Syrian and international networks of social movements, political parties and humanitarian organizations were discussing about the tragedy the Syrian population is suffering every day since four years as the result of a conflict which already has cost more than 200 000 lives, more than 100 000 prisoners and disappeared and produced more than 10 million refugees inside and outside of Syria.

They came to the conclusion that the extremists on both sides can only be defeated through a political solution based on a broad unity which establishes peace and social justice as its utmost goals. Thinking about the future of Syria it was said that this unity can only be produced through a democratic process respecting the diversity of cultures and religions within the framework of a decentralized government.

Given the example of Rojava in the Northeast of Syria where such a democratic and intercultural political structure has already been developed since 2013 the networks and organizations at the WSF proposes to organize an
